

Florida Bishops Oppose Extreme Abortion Amendment Vote No on Amendment 4

Florida Amendment 4, which will appear on Florida's November 2024 ballot, is an extreme proposal that legalizes fullterm abortion with no protections for the preborn child, including when the child is capable of feeling pain. This proposed amendment to our state constitution would prohibit all restrictions on abortion before viability and create a broad exception that any healthcare provider could exploit to allow abortion up to birth.

Furthermore, the amendment would effectively overturn or seriously jeopardize common-sense state laws that have regulated abortion for years. These include basic health and safety requirements for clinics where abortions are performed, requiring a physician to perform abortions, informed consent requirements, laws limiting public funding of abortion, and parental consent requirements before a minor's abortion. These risks demonstrate the extreme nature of the amendment.

We urge all Floridians of goodwill to stand against the legalization of late-term abortion and oppose the abortion amendment. In doing so, we will not only protect the weakest, most innocent, and defenseless of human life among us but also countless women throughout the state from the harms of abortion.

Human life is sacred. The dignity of the human person is the foundation of a moral vision of society. Direct attacks on innocent persons are never morally acceptable, at any stage or in any condition. In our state, human life is repeatedly being destroyed by abortion. Over 84,000 vulnerable and voiceless children were aborted in Florida in 2023.

This matter concerning the respect for human dignity and the fundamental value of human life is of grave importance to both our Church and our state. The threat of abortion remains our pre-eminent public policy priority. Therefore, we support a coordinated campaign to mobilize against the proposed amendment. To this end, we offer this prayer to defeat Amendment 4:

Ever-living God, you give life and desire a future for all your children. Take hold of our nation, state and community and awaken in every heart awe for the gift of life. Send your Spirit to strengthen us with wisdom and fortitude as we defend mothers and children in Florida from laws that disregard their health and safety.

Mary and Joseph trusted in you and welcomed Jesus into our broken world. God Almighty, we ask their intercession to protect the preborn and their mothers, and to guide all parents in raising their children. May they help us build a civilization of love by upholding the sacredness of life and accompanying pregnant women in need.

We ask this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

In the year 304, during the reign of Emperor Diocletian, in Abithynia, Africa, there was a group of 49 Christian martyrs declared guilty for having celebrated the Eucharist:

"We cannot be Christians without the Eucharist."

When I read about these holy martyrs, I was amazed at their enthusiasm and courage to respond to the love of the Eucharist. They preferred the sacrifice of death rather than renouncing the love of Jesus in the Eucharist. What do we think of them now? How much love and respect do I have for the Eucharist? Am I capable of dying if I were forbidden to attend Mass?

I think we need a lot of catechesis about not being indifferent to Jesus in the Eucharist. Let us be aware of what Pope Francis asks us to value:

"In the Eucharist, we contemplate and adore the God of love. It is the Lord, who does not break anyone but divides himself. It is the Lord, who does not demand sacrifices but sacrifices himself. It is the Lord, who asks for nothing, but gives everything. To celebrate and live the Eucharist, too, we are called to live this love. Because you can't break Sunday bread if your heart is closed to your brothers and sisters. You cannot eat this Bread if you do not share in the sufferings of those who are in need." (06-06-2021).

Pope Francis' message is clear and concise, we cannot eat of that Bread if we do not become bread broken to others.

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICA

En el año 304, durante el reinado del emperador Diocleciano, en Abitinia, África, hubo un grupo de 49 mártires cristianos declarados culpables por haber celebrado la Eucaristía:

"No podemos ser cristianos sin la Eucaristía".

Cuando leí sobre estos santos mártires, me sorprendí acerca de su entusiasmo y valor para responder sobre el amor a la Eucaristía. Ellos prefirieron el sacrificio de la muerte antes que renunciar al amor de Jesús en la Eucaristía. ¿Qué pensamos ahora de ellos? ¿Cuánto amor y respeto tengo por la Eucaristía? ¿Soy capaz de morir si me prohibieran asistir a Misa?

Creo que necesitamos muchas catequesis sobre no ser indiferentes ante Jesús Eucaristía. Seamos conscientes de lo que el Papa Francisco nos pide valorar:

"En la Eucaristía contemplamos y adoramos al Dios del amor. Es el Señor, que no quebranta a nadie, sino que se parte a sí mismo. Es el Señor, que no exige sacrificios, sino que se sacrifica él mismo. Es el Señor, que no pide nada, sino que entrega todo. Para celebrar y vivir la Eucaristía, también, nosotros estamos llamados a vivir este amor. Porque no puedes partir el Pan del domingo si tu corazón está cerrado a los hermanos. No puedes comer de este Pan si no compartes los sufrimientos del que está pasando necesidad". (06-06-2021).

El mensaje del Papa Francisco es claro y conciso, no podemos comer de ese Pan si no nos convertimos en pan partido a los demás.
