¿Qué es el Jubileo?

'Jubileo' es el nombre de un año particular: parece que deriva del instrumento utilizado para indicar su comienzo; se trata del *yobel*, el cuerno de carnero, cuyo sonido anuncia el Día de la Expiación (Yom Kippur). Esta fiesta se celebra cada año, pero adquiere un significado particular cuando coincide con el inicio del año jubilar. A este respecto, encontramos una primera idea en la Biblia: debía ser convocado cada 50 años, porque era el año 'extra', debía vivirse cada siete semanas de años (cfr. Lv 25,8-13). Aunque era difícil de realizar, se proponía como la ocasión para restablecer la correcta relación con Dios, con las personas y con la creación, y conllevaba el perdón de las deudas, la restitución de terrenos enajenados y el descanso de la tierra.



What is Jubilee?

'Jubilee' is the name of a particular year: it seems to derive from the instrument used to indicate its beginning; it is the *yobel*, the ram's horn, whose sound announces the Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur). This feast is celebrated every year, but acquires a particular significance when it coincides with the beginning of the Jubilee year. In this regard, we find a first idea in the Bible: it was to be called every 50 years, because it was the 'extra' year, it was to be lived every seven weeks of years (cf. Lev 25:8-13). Although it was difficult to carry out, it was proposed as the occasion to re-establish the right relationship with God, with people and with creation, and it entailed the forgiveness of debts, the restitution of alienated land and the resting of the earth.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

We have so many attractive and entertaining things that distract us greatly. Television, the computer, and especially our phone; We can spend the whole day looking at and looking for things that don't get us anywhere. Therefore, we should ask ourselves: Where do we place our eyes and thoughts? Jesus had none of these instruments to proclaim the Kingdom of God. He was given the scroll of the Prophet Isaiah, and he read the following: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me" (Luke 4:18). And that same Spirit of God is in us, waiting for a time of day to come together and look at each other.

The whole synagogue was attentive with their eyes fixed on him. And he said to them, "Today these prophetic words are fulfilled, and news of it comes to you" (Luke 4:21). "Christ is the author and guide of all gospel activity that is exposed. The Prophecy also foretells that after him his disciples will be the ministers of this task when it says: "How beautiful are the feet of the messenger when he proclaims peace!" (Isaiah 52:7). It refers to the beautiful feet of Christ's messengers. How could they not be beautiful, if, in a short time, they were going to travel the world and fill every corner of the earth with that holy doctrine of the Savior?" (Eusebius of Caesarea (260-340 The Evangelical Demonstration). Let us always remember that the Word of God is spirit and life.

MEDITACIÓN EVANGÉLICA

Tenemos tantas cosas atrayentes y entretenidas que nos distraen grandemente. La televisión, la computadora, y sobre todo nuestro teléfono; podemos pasar el día entero viendo y buscando cosas que no nos llevan a ningún lado. Cabe pues, que nos preguntemos lo siguiente: ¿Dónde ponemos nuestros ojos, nuestro pensamiento? Jesús, no tenía nada de estos instrumentos para anunciar el Reino de Dios. A Él se le entregó el rollo del Profeta Isaías, y leyó lo siguiente: "El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí" (Lucas 4:18). Y ese mismo Espíritu de Dios está en nosotros, esperando que llegue un momento del día para estar juntos y mirarnos.

Toda la sinagoga estaba atenta con los ojos clavados en él. Y les dijo: "Hoy se cumplen estas palabras proféticas y a ustedes les llegan noticias de ello" (Lucas 4:21). "Cristo es el autor y guía de toda actividad evangélica que está expuesta. También la profecía predice que después de él sus propios discípulos serán los ministros de esta tarea cuando dice: "¡Qué hermosos son los pies del mensajero cuando anuncia la paz!" (Isaías 52:7). Se refiere a los pies hermosos de los mensajeros de Cristo. ¿Cómo no iban a ser hermosos, si en breve tiempo iban a recorrer el mundo e iban a llenar cada rincón de la tierra con esa santa doctrina del Salvador?" (Eusebio de Cesarea (260-340 La Demostración evangélica). Recordemos siempre, que la Palabra de Dios es espíritu y vida.
